

Essential Jewish Heritage Tour – 2,5 hours

First, your guide shows you the most important chapters of the Hungarian Jewry's history and the Elizabethtown. Meanwhile we walk on the streets of the so-called Pest Jewish Quarter, we are going to explore the „status quo ante” Rumbach Street Synagogue (outside visit).



As the highlight of the tour, we visit the Dohány Street Synagogue (interior visit), which is the largest in Europe and the second largest in the world.

You also get a local guided tour in the Jewish Museum, where you get acquainted with the Hungarian Jewish heritage through a unique collection of art pieces from Hungary and Eastern Europe, and the rich tradition of Judaism, its holidays and everyday life. A separate room commemorates the Hungarian Holocaust.

Beside these we visit the Martyrs' Cemetery, the Raoul Wallenberg Memorial Park with the Tree of Life and the Heroes' Temple (outside visit). After the tour it is possible to visit the Jewish Quarter Exhibition in the Goldmark Hall and the Family Research Center.

At the end of the tour you will be given a Jewish Centre entrance ticket. These tickets are valid for one entry during next 24 hours. If you would like to go back the next day to the Jewish Centre, please keep your ticket and show it at the entrance gate.

The dates of the Jewish Heritage Essential Tour in English language:

From November 2nd to 30th 2016:

Every day at 10 am except on Saturday.

From May 1st to October 31th 2017:

Monday to Thursday at 10 am and 2 pm and on Friday and Sunday at 10 am- except on Saturday.

From November 2nd to 30th 2017:

Every day at 10 am except on Saturday.

We don't have tours on Jewish holidays, when the great Synagogue is closed for guiding. (those dates can not be booked on the sites linked below).
